Born in Snellville, GA, Emily Fennell began her training with Baltimore Ballet at the age of ten. Emily went on to study at the Kirov Academy of Washington DC and Grand Ballet Vancouver under Yeu-Jung Lee. In 2012, she was awarded a scholarship to attend The Harid Conservatory.
